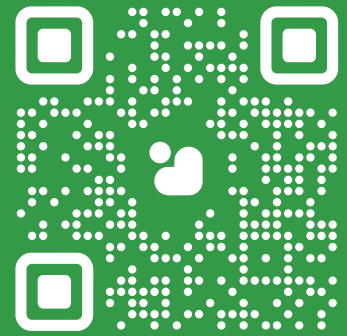
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Welcome!

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OLYMPICS OF DANCE

Reddam House Waterfall bound for Dance World Cup Finals



In the competitive world of performing arts, success is rarely a matter of luck; it is a product of rigorous systems, elite talent management, and immense commitment.

This business-like precision has propelled the dance team from Jelea Dance Studio Reddam House Waterfall to the pinnacle of their craft: qualifying for the Dance World Cup Finals 2026 in Dublin, Ireland, from 8-18 July 2026.

The Olympics of Dance

The Dance World Cup is widely considered one of the most prestigious dance events on the global calendar – essentially the Olympics of Dance. The stakes are incredibly high, with only the most proficient dancers from 66 countries competing for a spot on the international stage.

In South Africa, the regional qualifiers were held at Lewende Woord in Centurion. To qualify, a team must rank within the top four in their specific genre – a feat achieved by the Reddam Waterfall Junior team (ages 14-17).

The team, made up of 14 dancers, wowed judges with their artistry and passion to secure their tickets to Dublin.

They are: Lily-Rose Julie, Sahil Seetaram, Kemeeka Pillay, Vida Neumann, Ava Schmidt, Sarah Bosch, Ella Schmidt, Kiara Renney, Julia Grace, Tyla Murray-Smith, Camilla Fonternel, Kananelo Buthelezi, Oreeditse Rakgokong, and Zaniah McCoy. Twelve of these 14 dancers will represent South Africa at the finals.

A strategy for success

The path to Ireland is paved with huge commitment. The process begins every



January with open auditions to select the competitive team. Once chosen, the dancers enter a gruelling year-round schedule.

“Team rehearsals are offered after the standard classes and if you are part of a duo or doing a solo, it can be up to five extra rehearsals a week,” explains Jenna Fieldgate of Jelea Dance Studio Reddam House Waterfall.

The team competed across several technical genres, including: Contemporary (Jenna’s favourite for its storytelling power); Jazz, Tap, and Lyrical (which is a fluid, expressive dance that blends ballet techniques

with the freedom of jazz and contemporary style to convey music’s emotion and rhythm).

The return on investment

For these students – all current or past Reddam House Waterfall pupils – the rewards extend far beyond trophies. Top performers in SA can receive sponsorships covering flights to the world championships, but the real value lies in the networking and professional development.

“Even just being at the competition is a big deal as you get to have masterclasses with world-renowned dance instructors and choreographers,”

says Jenna. This exposure to global standards is a career-defining highlight for both the students and their mentors.

Looking ahead

With the first regional competitions of the new year – The Next Level of Dance 2026 and World Dance Challenge – kicking off in March, the team is already using their World Cup routines, choreographed by Jenna and supporting dance teacher Summer Steenkamp, for practice.

As Jenna notes, “This is the biggest achievement of our dance school”. When the team lands in Dublin in July 2026, they won’t just be dancers; they will be ambassadors for South African excellence, representing the grit and artistry that defines Reddam House Waterfall.

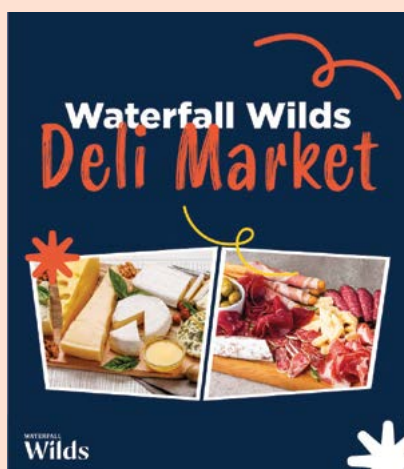

THE GREATEST GIFT

Twins reunited after fight for survival

Kwandokuhle healthy and doing well after his successful PDA ligation procedure.



Being together over the recent festive season had special significance for the Ndlovu family, due to one of their identical twin babies finally returning home after spending months fighting for his life in a paediatric intensive care unit in another province.

“Our twin boys, Kwandokuhle and Kwenzokuhle, were born in April 2025 and at the end of May, when they were just over a month old, both of them developed a flu-like illness. We rushed them to the hospital, and Kwenzo was placed in isolation while we awaited their blood test results,” Andile Ndlovu, from Howick in KwaZulu-Natal, recalls.

Both twins tested positive for respiratory syncytial virus (RSV), and doctors discovered a hole in Kwando’s heart that further complicated his situation. While Kwenzo remained in the local hospital, his twin’s condition deteriorated and doctors discussed the need to transfer Kwando for specialised care to Netcare Waterfall City Hospital in Gauteng.

“We were so worried about him, as his life was in danger. There was however an option for specialised treatment called extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (ECMO), but this also came with risks that we had to be aware of,” Mr Ndlovu recalls.

Netcare, together with specially trained advanced life support paramedics and cardiothoracic surgeon Dr Sharmel Bhika, operate an ECMO retrieval transport service specifically for children like Kwando, who are too critically ill to be transferred by conventional ambulance services.

“ECMO is a form of life support

in which specialised equipment artificially performs the functions of the heart and lungs, giving them a chance to heal. It was a clear indication in Kwandokuhle's case as his rapid deterioration and increased demand on mechanical ventilatory support were possibly causing more harm to his body; and secondly, ECMO would be required for the safe long-distance transfer of our tiny patient," Dr Bhika says.

"ECMO is not viable for every child in respiratory distress. Even for clinically appropriate patients who receive this advanced heart and lung support as a last resort, the odds against survival remain significant. But for some, like baby Kwandokuhle, it offers a chance for recovery where there is otherwise very little hope," she adds.

"A long-distance ECMO retrieval for such a small patient requires meticulous planning and co-ordination from many specialised team members. An undertaking of this magnitude required the team to move equipment for the procedure to KwaZulu-Natal, and then transport little Kwandokuhle while on ECMO to Gauteng," says Mande Toubkin, Netcare's general manager of emergency, trauma, transplant and corporate social investment.

"It was so painful for us to see about 20 medical professionals around our small baby. It took four hours to prepare Kwando for ECMO, which

went well and the next morning he was ready for the journey on ECMO," Mr Ndlovu recalls of the anxious time.

In Kwandokuhle's case, he was put on veno-arterial ECMO life-support to allow his lungs to rest and recover, while supporting his heart throughout his ambulance journey from the local hospital to the airport in Pietermaritzburg, then on a medical evacuation flight to Lanseria and finally by ambulance to the receiving team at Netcare Waterfall City Hospital's paediatric intensive care unit.

Paediatric intensivist Dr Palesa Monyake recalls how desperately ill Kwandokuhle was when he first arrived at Netcare Waterfall City Hospital's paediatric ICU: "A baby so young hasn't had the chance to develop a strong immune system, so his body was fighting this ravaging lung infection on the one hand, while his little heart was also struggling due to the congenital defect. We were all extremely concerned for him, but we were determined to give him the best possible chance of survival," Dr Monyake says.

Around the clock, the dedicated ECMO trained PICU nurses and doctors did everything they could for Kwandokuhle, including the power of prayer. Although his condition on ECMO life support and medication remained serious, the Ndlovu family had to return home to Kwenzokuhle

in KwaZulu-Natal, visiting whenever possible. All the while Dr Monyake and the PICU team cared for Kwando as he remained sedated on ECMO.

"Eventually, after a difficult road, the day finally came when Kwandokuhle recovered sufficiently for us to take him off ECMO, but his lungs were still under strain because of his heart defect. He faced a last major hurdle – the time had come for the surgery to repair his heart," Dr Monyake says.

The surgery would correct his congenital cardiac lesion patent ductus arteriosus (PDA). Without surgery, a PDA can cause a significant increase in blood flow to the baby's lungs, raising pulmonary arterial blood pressures, which in Kwandokuhle's case could result in difficulty weaning him off the ventilator and a more protracted ICU course," Dr Bhika explains.

"Fortunately, Kwandokuhle's PDA ligation procedure was successful, and he returned to the PICU, where under the constant care of specially trained PICU nurses and Dr Monyake, he was weaned off oxygen and began to gain weight healthily. This timely procedure likely prevented ICU complications and risks of further lung pathology," Dr Bhika says.

When the Ndlovu family arrived to see Kwando the morning after his heart operation, they were relieved to see their son's dramatic improvement. Having spent half his young life separated from his twin and parents while on life support, Kwandokuhle was finally well enough to return to KwaZulu-Natal to a hospital closer to his family.

"We are so happy! It is the greatest gift to have our twins healthy at home and reunited. We celebrated our first Christmas together as a family at home last year. Kwando and Kwenzo play together so beautifully, and we are recording these memories for the twins when they grow up."

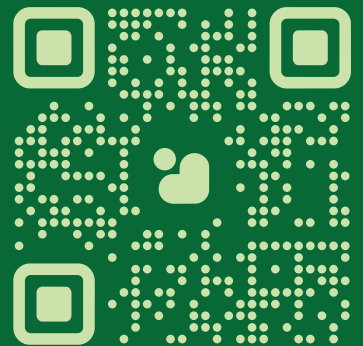
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YOUR ESTATE PLAN

Estate planning and retirement planning are rarely discussed in the same breath. This is because they focus on different life stages, and are therefore thought of as separate aspects of financial planning. However, it's important to consider your retirement funds when constructing your estate plan.

Estate planning focuses on how your assets will be managed and distributed after your death. It ensures your wishes are honoured and helps minimise taxes and legal complications for your heirs. Retirement planning, on the other hand, focuses on accumulating and managing resources to support your lifestyle after you stop working. It helps to provide you with financial security during your retirement years.

Financial advisers use various strategies and products to assist their clients in realising these goals. Your will, for example, is the primary document used to implement your estate plan. Retirement annuities are products that are specifically designed for individuals who want to save for their retirement in a tax-efficient manner, providing them with both a cash lump sum and a regular income after

retirement, by purchasing either a guaranteed annuity or a living annuity with the proceeds.

The reality is that both retirement planning and estate planning form part of a holistic financial plan, and retirement products – particularly retirement annuities (RAs) and living annuities (LAs) – play a significant role in estate planning.

Retirement products and deceased estates

From an estate planning perspective, one of the foremost benefits of RAs and LAs is that they generally do not form part of your deceased estate when you pass away. This means that the proceeds of these products will not be tied up during the process of winding up your estate, and your dependants will have access to these much-needed funds to sustain their lifestyle and financial wellbeing. No executor's fees will be levied on these products, and the proceeds will not be subject to estate duty.

An often-overlooked aspect of estate administration is contributions made to an RA before retirement. These contributions are tax deductible up to the annual legislative limits (currently 27.5% of taxable income is capped at R350,000). It is possible to contribute more than these limits and still benefit from tax-efficient estate planning. The larger your contributions to an RA, the more substantial the portion of your wealth that will be excluded from your estate when you pass away. Furthermore, section 10C of the Income Tax Act allows these excess contributions (referred to as disallowed contributions) to be offset against the income you draw from your LA until your disallowed contributions have been depleted. Because section 10C allows for a tax exemption, you will effectively receive your income back from SARS at the end of the tax year, making these funds available to further your financial goals and aspirations.

Disallowed contributions will also be deducted from any lump sums that



your beneficiaries elect to take from the proceeds of your RA or LA when you pass away, thereby reducing your tax burden in respect of the lump sum. A note of caution though: the disallowed contributions deducted will be included in your estate for estate duty purposes.

Distribution of proceeds

It is important to understand that you cannot entirely rely on the provisions of your will when it comes to the distribution of the proceeds of your RA.

An RA is a type of retirement fund, and the proceeds will therefore be distributed in terms of section 37C of the Pension Funds Act. The purpose of this legislation is to ensure that those who were dependent on the deceased are not left destitute. Section 37C makes provision for this by requiring the trustees of retirement annuity funds to exercise equitable discretion in distributing the member's death benefit. More specifically, the trustees must:

- Actively investigate to identify and trace potential dependants and assess their degree of dependency on the deceased member. The trustees have 12 months in which to finalise this investigation.
- Make an equitable distribution, taking into account factors such as a dependant's age, relationship to the deceased and extent of dependency, the deceased's wishes, and the dependant's financial position.
- Determine how to effect payment – for instance, paying a minor's share into a beneficiary fund or a beneficiary share to a trust that

was nominated in the will of the deceased

The importance of nominating beneficiaries

A smooth transfer of wealth is perhaps one of the most important considerations in estate planning. Beneficiary nominations are the most practical and cost-effective way to achieve this. Beneficiaries can be nominated on both an RA and an LA, but with different implications.

In the case of an LA, the proceeds will be paid directly to your nominated beneficiaries, who may elect to take the proceeds as a cash lump sum (subject to tax) or to purchase an annuity in their own name. This enables planning for an uninterrupted income stream after you pass away. However, if you neglect to nominate a beneficiary, the proceeds will be paid to your deceased estate.

As the trustees of a retirement annuity fund are legally required to determine your dependants in terms of section 37C, your beneficiary nomination form will not necessarily be followed. However, it will provide guidance to the trustees as to who your dependants were at the time of your death and the extent of their dependency on you. If you have no dependants (and your estate is solvent), the proceeds will be paid in terms of your nomination form.

Pre-and post-retirement products play a crucial role in your estate plan. Speak to your financial adviser about incorporating your retirement planning into a well-structured estate plan.

Rediscovering Sun City

The last time I set foot in Sun City was for a Black-Eyed Peas concert; the time before that, it was for those fun school summer parties where a bus from Sandton whisked us away to the Valley of Waves. Even further back, in December 1992, I was lucky to be at the grand opening of the five-star Palace of the Lost City, which came complete with a dazzling light show by Jean-Michel Jarre.

Fast-forward to the present day and a chance to revisit Sun City presented itself. Still, my busy life in Gauteng had led me to think Sun City was a distant dream – but after a surprisingly shortish two-hour, 20-minute drive, we arrived. Thanks to the Sun Vacation Club Friday-to-Friday timeshare option, the drive proved to be worth every kilometre.

So, what did I discover after such a long absence? Sun City is still utterly fabulous!

That familiar “wow” factor hit us all as we drove in, spotting the iconic turrets of The Palace peeking out. The resort itself has grown exponentially: it now boasts The Cascades; The Palace of the Lost City; The Cabanas; Sun City Hotel; and the Sun Vacation Club, their fantastic timeshare offering.

Our home for the next few days was The Reserve, a beloved cornerstone of the Sun City holiday experience. This self-catering haven, initially established in 1996, has undergone a massive R210-million refurbishment. The revamp follows the overwhelming success of Lefika Villas, which introduced the upmarket self-catering model.

Nestled amongst indigenous acacia and leopard trees, The Reserve has always felt a step closer to the wilderness. Now, thanks to a reimagined design by Blacksmith Interior Inspiration, the interiors actively encourage “escapism into the African wild”.

Ryan Ilgner, director of Blacksmith, explains the company’s





vision: "We want guests to feel instantly transported into the heart of the African wild. The design draws from natural materials and textures – from stone-look tiles to woven savannah-inspired wallpapers and bespoke animal-pattern fabrics in bold, vibrant hues. Larger-than-life wildlife portraits turn headboards into art, while soft blue ceilings and ambient lighting evoke the tranquility of dusk in the bush."

Our double-storey unit at The Reserve was a modern, elegant and comfortable space, bursting with gorgeous blues, turquoises and mustards. Each unit is distinctly themed. Ours featured majestic rhino-printed headboards and stunning black-and-white photography.

Upstairs, we found three comfortable bedrooms, with the main en-suite room boasting a king-size bed. There was plenty of space for everyone, and the comfy couches could easily sleep a child or two.

With three bathrooms in total, a well-equipped kitchen, a fabulous lounge and TV, and an elegant dining area, we were set. Outside, a braai area and a large patio meant we were ready for a week of pure relaxation and epic entertainment.

Valley of Waves

Sun City has so much on offer, you need to plan carefully to make the most of your time – there's even a cinema! Of course, the resort's crown jewel remains the Valley of Waves. Even the entrance is dramatic as you walk across the mighty bridge lined with elephants. At the same time, the faces of animals carved into the rock look down at you from above.

The beach is pristine, and the huge waves that periodically sweep through the pool elicit shrieks of delight from kids and adults alike.

Milky Lane offers the best ice cream mid-morning snack; you can grab a Corona at the Beach Bar; and Wimpy provides late breakfast fries.

We chilled on the sand, watching adventurers conquer the tree-top challenge and the Chimp & Zee zipline that flies right over the waves. With lifeguards everywhere, it's a secure and fantastic place to spend the day.

Activities

Next up was a family challenge at the Little Big Rock Putt-Putt course. It looked simple, but this course was a delightful mix of complex angles and epic fails!



Right next door, we found a solar-heated pool with two smaller slides, a basketball court and the brilliant Jump Park. Alas, bouncing is for kids only, and they had an absolute blast – a clever addition to Sun City’s activities.

While you may be tempted to use your self-catering kitchen, you’ll also find a Spur by the pool and an Ocean Basket just down the road. But if you do want to cook, The Pantry is a lifesaver – it’s a great shop stocking everything from braai packs and ready meals to biscuits, chocolate and tin foil. Next door, a bottle store ensures you’re stocked for sundowners.

En route to Valley of Waves, a vibrant food court awaits, complete with sweet shops, a Lego store and a massive arcade. We inevitably got stuck here, but it was entertaining watching the kids and dad battling it out on Terminator, Deal or No Deal and The Claw.

For the seriously energetic, there are various sports on offer: a weekly parkrun, the famous Gary Player and Lost City golf courses, and The Cascades boasts numerous tennis and padel courts – I think we counted six padel courts. With music pumping and a coffee shop on site, it’s a great way to work off those breakfast fries and build an appetite for the next meal.

Like any sprawling resort, there are also loads of activities for the kids, mostly poolside. Bingo was a hot favourite, and the vibrant atmosphere continued all day.

The resort is massive, but a clever bus network makes getting from A to B safe and efficient, and it gives teens a wonderful sense of freedom.

Kudos to the staff

One of the most memorable aspects of our Sun City trip was the staff. Their constant smiles, cheerful “good mornings” and even a few hugs from people like Maye and Angus made our trip special and memorable. Their dedication to customer service is commendable.

It’s these personal touches that make Sun City more than just a resort. Everyone was on hand to ensure we had the best time ever, and you know what? We absolutely did!

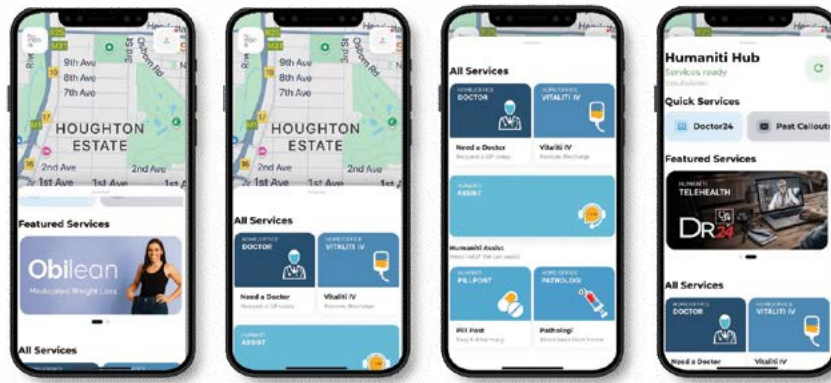

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TRADITIONAL HOMEMADE HOT CROSS BUNS

Recipe by Abigail Donnelly

Hot cross buns are a cherished treat, lovingly baked with warm spices and sweet dried fruits that fill the kitchen with a comforting aroma. Why not make your own traditional hot cross buns this Easter with this delicious recipe, and fill your home with the irresistible scent and warmth of freshly baked goodness?

Ingredients

480g flour
2 x 10g instant yeast sachets
10g brown sugar
½ tsp cinnamon
½ tsp nutmeg
Salt, a pinch
½ tsp baking powder
½ tsp bicarbonate of soda
1 lemon, zested
1 ¼ cups of milk
3 tbsp butter
2 free-range eggs
1 tsp vanilla extract
135g sultanas and raisins

For the flour paste:

125g flour
5 tbsp water

For the glaze:

65ml golden syrup
65ml boiling water



Method

Preheat the oven to 180°C.

To make the hot cross buns

- Combine the flour, yeast, brown sugar, cinnamon, nutmeg, salt, baking powder, bicarbonate of soda, lemon zest and dried fruit in a large mixing bowl.
- Place the milk and butter in a saucepan and heat gently until the butter has melted. Lightly whisk the eggs and vanilla together and add to the dry ingredients, along with the milk-and-butter mixture.
- Gently mix the dough using your hands or a wooden spoon until the mixture comes together.
- Turn the dough out onto a clean surface and knead for 10 minutes.
- Place in a lightly oiled bowl, cover with clingfilm and place in a warm spot for

1½ hours until doubled in size.

- After the dough has risen, knock it down to its original size and then roll into 12 evenly shaped buns.
- Place the buns on a greased baking tray and cover with clingfilm, leaving enough room for the buns to rise. Allow the buns to rise for another 30 minutes.

To make the flour paste

- Mix the flour and water together to form a smooth paste, place it in a Ziploc sandwich bag and cut off one of the corners to make a piping bag.
- Pipe a cross onto each bun and bake for 15 minutes, or until the buns are golden and cooked through. Glaze the buns while they are still hot.

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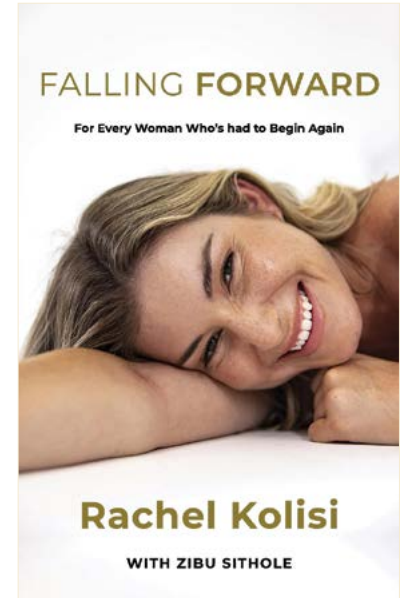
FALLING FORWARD

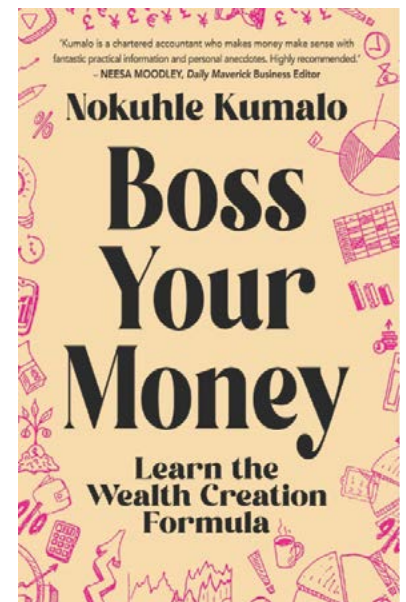

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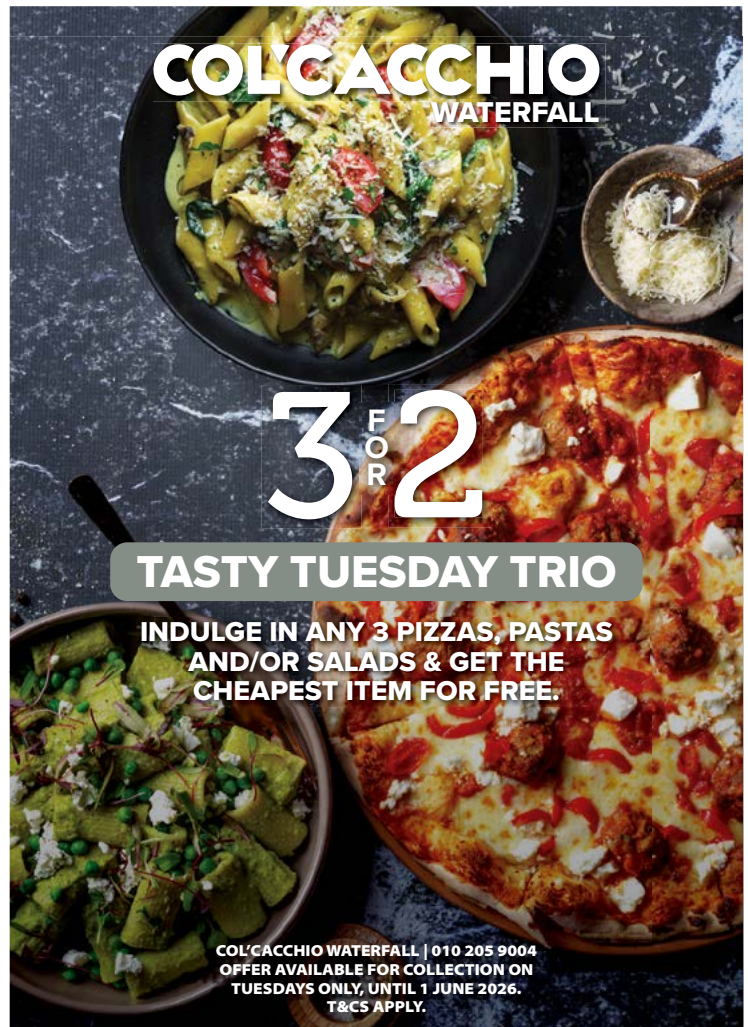
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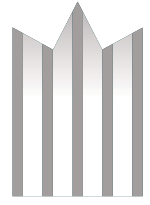
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
